

Floor Map

Note to Visitors



Borrowing

How to borrow

Books can be checked out at the counter or the self service machine with your ID card, student ID card or Library card.

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We can issue a Library card for members of the Faculty of Science who do not have any IC cards (listed above). Please submit "Kyoto University Library Card Registration Form" to the counter with your ID.

*If you have an overdue book that has not been returned, you can not check out another book.

- *You can extend the loan period (renew) only once (only books).
- The latest issues may not be borrowed.
- Some Audio-Visual materials (CD/DVD) can not be checked out. You can view it at the Audio-Visual Room on BF.
- Reference Books are in-library use only. In the following cases, you can borrow them at the counter.
- Temporary borrowing to copy: short-term loan only : until 7:00 pm
- Over-night loan:

from 6:00 pm (4:00 pm) until 9:00 am on the following day

Returning
